BS in Educational Psychology

Department of Education at SZABIST offers BS in educational psychology as a non-teaching program. This program has been designed to meet the international standards in the field of educational psychology which opens multiple doors to facilitate aspired students with diversity and compatibility. The emphasis of the program is not limited to the theoretical aspects but it will abridge practical approach with the educational industry to foster the integration of psychology in education. The outcome of this course would be useful for the graduates to seek master and doctoral programs providing them diversified options in the domains of psychology, education, mental health counselling, school counselling and psychology, and clinical psychology.

Program Mission

The program will seek to develop a holistic program to produce professionals who can understand, interpret and analyze parameters of educational psychology and apply their knowledge for the betterment of education in society.

Program Structure

BS Educational Psychology is a 4-year degree program, consists of 144 credit hours/48 courses including 15 general courses, 19 core courses, 12 major courses, 6 credit hour research project.

Admission Requirements

For admission in the BS (Educational Psychology) programs, the candidate must have completed O-Levels (minimum 8 subjects including 5 compulsory subjects; English, Urdu, Maths, Islamiat & Pakistan Studies) and A-levels (minimum 3 Subjects)/12th Grade/Intermediate with minimum 50% marks or equivalent from a recognized institution.

Inter Board Committee of Chairmen (IBCC) equivalency is required for O & A Levels/ IB Diploma/High School Diploma or equivalent. General Paper (A Levels) will not be counted.

Bachelor of Education (B.Ed) 1.5 Years

The Bachelor of Education (B.Ed.) 1.5 years program at SZABIST is intended to help pre-service and in service teachers develop the required knowledge and skills to enter the educational sector as a competent and knowledgeable teacher with a grip on teaching different subjects in grades in public and private sector. The proposed program has been specifically designed for students from non-educational background who want to now shift to serving and getting a degree in education. After the program completion, students will be eligible to apply for the MS/MPhil in Education.

Program Mission

The Bachelor of Education (B.Ed.) program strives to prepare thoughtful, knowledgeable, lifelong learners who have extensive knowledge about working with students of various age groups and who understand the inherent richness of educational endeavors. The program's mission is to help students' get familiar with research, understand the complexities of learning, human development, and sound pedagogical principles as well as develop grounding in content knowledge. The program's goal is to prepare graduates who are committed to supporting just, engaging, and successful communities of diverse learners.

Program Structure

B.Ed. is a 1.5 years degree program offered to pre-service and in-service teachers. It is a 54 credit hour program with 12 core courses (3 credit hours each), 4 content specialized courses (3 credit hours each), 3 credit hours teaching practice and 3 credit hours research project. The maximum time limit to complete the B.Ed. degree is four years.

Admission Requirements

- For admission in the B.Ed. program, the candidate must possess 16-years of Education (MA, M.Sc., M.Com. or equivalent) in any discipline with minimum Second Division/2.00 CGPA from a university recognized by HEC.
- Last degree verification from HEC is required.

MS in Educational Leadership and Management (Evening/Weekend)

The MS in Educational Leadership and Management Program at the Department of Education seeks to meet national and international standards of educational study and research. It is in conformity with the HEC guidelines and caters to the interests of a diverse set of learners who have chosen education to be their field of study. It prepares them for practical leadership roles with sound theoretical standing to make informed decisions.

Program Mission

The program aims to produce highly intellectual leaders and managers with influence on educational policy and reform. It envisages identifying challenges in global and local education, addressing issues in education through knowledge and research, and ultimately improving the standards of the prevailing educational system.

Program Structure

The MS in Education and Leadership and Management is 1.5-2 years program. It's a 30 credit hours' program in which two streams are available. One Stream is Course Work Based Stream and other one is Research Based Stream. In Course Work Stream, the student is required to complete 10 courses of 3 credit hours each. In the Research Based Stream, the student is required to complete 8 Courses (24 Credit Hours) and Two IRS (6 Credit Hours) OR One Thesis (6 Credit Hours). In both the streams, 30 Credit hours to be completed.

The students will have the opportunity to specialize in the fields of Sociology of Education, Educational Policy, Testing and Evaluation, Teacher Education, Professional Development, School Administration/Educational Leadership, Guidance & Counseling, Curriculum development, Technology Integration in Education, Early Childhood Education, Higher Education studies, Educational Psychology and Child Development.

Admission Requirements

- For admission in MS ELM program, the candidate must possess 16-years of education in the discipline of education with minimum second division/2.0 CGPA from an HEC recognized institution. Or 16-years of Education in any other field may apply but will require to complete six deficiency courses.
- GAT General/HAT relevant with minimum 50% score is also required.

Note: Candidates applying with 16 years of Education and 1-year B.Ed. degree are required to complete 06 bridging courses of 18 credits at SZABIST.

PhD in Educational Leadership and Management (Evening)

The PhD in Educational Leadership and Management program at the Department of Education aspires to meet the growing demand of leaders and managers with expertise in the field of education. There is a strong emphasis on research, and critical awareness on issues of social justice and equity in educational contexts. It equips graduates with the knowledge and skills to have impact on educational policy, reform, and practice.

Program Mission

The program is designed to ensure dissemination and application of synergistic knowledge leading towards making best educational decisions and practices. It aims to equip learners with pedagogical skills dynamically fueled by the process of engagement in local contexts and critical awareness of transnational situations.

Program Structure

PhD in Educational Leadership and Management is a minimum 3 year program spread over minimum six semesters. It is a 54 credit hours program comprising 7 courses (21 credit hours), 1 Independent Research Study (3 credit hours), and a Dissertation (30 credit hours).

The students will have the opportunity to specialize in the fields of Sociology of Education, Educational Policy, Testing/Evaluation, Teacher Education, Professional Development, School Administration/Educational Leadership, Guidance & Counselling, Educational Psychology, and Curriculum development, Technology Integration in Education, Early Childhood Education, Higher Education Studies, Educational Psychology and Child Development.

Admission Requirements

- A candidate must have 17.5 years of education in the relevant discipline, i.e. an MS/ M.Phil in Education/Educational Leadership and Management, with minimum 60% marks/CGPA 3.00 from an HEC recognized institution.
- GAT subject/GRE is mandatory for PhD students with minimum 60% score.
- Last degree verification from HEC is required.
